

Configure Wireless on a Wi-Fi enabled BlackBerry

Follow the instructions below to set up your Wi-Fi enabled BlackBerry to connect to McGill's wireless network. The connection information can be saved in a Wi-Fi profile.

Note: Your BlackBerry tries to connect to Wi-Fi networks based on the order in which they appear in your Wi-Fi profile list. By default, new Wi-Fi profiles appear at the bottom of your Wi-Fi profile list.

1. On the Home screen or in the application list, click **Set Up Wi-Fi**.
2. If your Wi-Fi is not enabled, select **Turn Wi-Fi On**.
3. Click **Scan for Networks**.
4. Select **wpa.mcgill.ca *** (WPA/WPA2-Enterprise). Fill in the following fields:
 - o Name: **wpa.mcgill.ca ***
 - o SSID: **wpa.mcgill.ca ***
 - o Security Type: **PEAP**
 - o User Name: **McGill Username**
 - o User password: **McGill Password**
 - o CA Certificate: **thawte Primary Root CA**
 - o Inner Link Security: **EAP-MS-CHAP V2**
 - o Token: **None Selected**
 - o Server subject: **blank**
 - o Server San: **blank**
5. Save the profile so that you can easily connect to the McGill wireless network.
6. Click **Finish**.

- **eduroam** (reserved for members of the [eduroam service](#)) - non-McGill users visiting McGill and McGill users visiting another institution)
- **wpa.bus.mcgill.ca** (wireless on inter-campus shuttle buses)
- **CUSM-MUHC.MCGILL.CA** (wireless in certain areas of the McGill University Health Centre) **Note to MUHC staff:** If you do not see this option, and wish to request the installation of a new MUHC wireless access point, please contact MUHC Information Services at **514-934-8484**.
