

Configure Wireless on an iPhone or iPod Touch

Follow the instructions below to set up a connection to McGill's wireless network using Wi-Fi Protected Access (WPA).

1. Go to the Menu and click **Settings**.



2. Select **Wi-Fi** and make sure the Wi-Fi is turned **On**.



3. Select one of the following:
- **wpa.mcgill.ca**
 - **wpa.rez.mcgill.ca** ([wireless connectivity in McGill residences](#))
 - **eduroam** (reserved for members of the [eduroam service](#) - non-McGill users visiting McGill and McGill users visiting another institution)
 - **wpa.bus.mcgill.ca** ([wireless on inter-campus shuttle buses](#))
 - **CUSM-MUHC.MCGILL.CA** ([wireless network of MUHC \(McGill University Health Centre\)](#) found in certain areas) **Note to MUHC staff:** If you do not see this option, and wish to request the installation of a new MUHC wireless access point, please contact MUHC Information Services at **514-934-8484**.

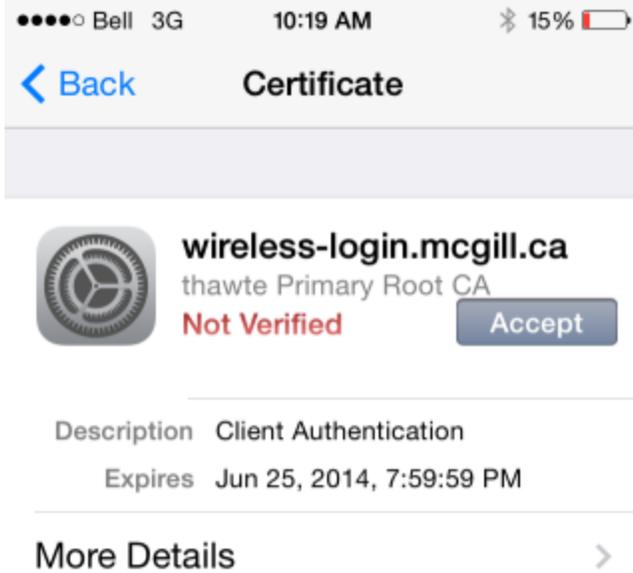


4. Enter your [McGill Username](#) and McGill Password > click **Join** to join McGill's wireless network.



5. Click **Accept** for the **thawte Primary Root CA Certificate**.

Note that the certificate will say "Not Verified", but you should accept it anyway, as long as it comes from a "Thawte" source, with the address of "wireless-login.mcgill.ca".



6. You are now successfully connected to McGill's wireless network.



7. Return to the main Menu and click on the **Safari** icon to go to a website (ie. www.google.com) verify that you have wireless connectivity.
